The Midland Pullman was Britain's first luxury high speed diesel-electric train running in the early 1960's between Manchester Central and London St Pancras, offering the best possible at seat deluxe service and is remembered for the trains striking Nanking blue livery, white jacketed stewards, and impeccable customer service – To celebrate the 60th anniversary of this iconic train we are honoured to present our own refurbished high speed train as a faithful revival.

Our restored HST (High Speed Train) Is now 46 years old and is the only one in preservation capable of speeds up to 125mph on the main line - we proudly offer day and weekend tours throughout Britain to enticing destinations and over routes, many of which, never experienced these magnificent trains when they were in daily service.

Seating is at tables of 4 or 2 with wide seats and panoramic windows and includes complimentary tea/coffee and light snacks, accompanied with a morning glass of Bucks Fizz and afternoon glass of sparkling wine. 
PULLMAN DINING


TICKETS & TIMINGS



We are delighted to present a three-day weekend break to the Highlands of Scotland at this most dramatic and beautiful time of year with the prospect of snow covered mountains as they glisten in winter sunlight – The journey will be over the entire length of the world-famous West Highland line, featuring some of the most spectacular scenery in Scotland crossing magnificent bridges and viaducts offering views of tumbling waterfalls and peaceful lochs.

Friday: Our train travels north through the Scottish Lowlands, thence to Glasgow and along the banks of the River Clyde, where we join the scenic and spectacular West Highland line. Passing Loch Long and Loch Lomond we climb high into the mountains for a memorable journey over the wild expanse of snow-covered Rannoch Moor with an arrival into Fort William around 20.30.

Saturday: Departing Fort William mid-morning for the magnificent 84-mile round trip on the 'Jacobite' line to Mallaig - Passing Ben Nevis we travel along the shoreline of Loch Eil and at Glenfinnan cross the viaduct featured in the 'Harry Potter' movies offering stunning vistas down Loch Shiel and regarded as the most spectacular view in Britain. There will be a short break in the pretty fishing port of Mallaig before retracing our outward route past the white sands of Morar with an arrival back in Fort William about 14.00 with the remainder of the afternoon at leisure for sightseeing.

Sunday: Departing Fort William around 09.00 we travel up the Great Glen, passing the falls of Orchy and through Monessie Gorge, then alongside Loch Treig with stunning views of the Nevis Range. Continuing homeward around the Horseshoe Curve and County March summit.

This special tour includes a journey over the entire majestic route of the famous Settle to Carlisle railway, with great limestone peaks and deep valleys we travel over viaducts and through tunnels on this masterpiece of Victorian engineering including the famous Ribblehead Viaduct. Following a break in the historic border city of Carlisle our journey continues along the scenic Cumbrian coastal line.

Our train heads into the Yorkshire Dales for a spectacular journey over the magnificent high Pennines. The sheer scale of the scenery is apparent as we pass such famous landmarks as Ribblehead Viaduct with stunning views of the three peaks. One magnificent sight follows another before we gradually descend into the tranquil Eden Valley and the border city of Carlisle for a break of around two hours.

We return around the longest and most scenic coastal line in England – the beautiful twisting Cumbrian coast route hugs the coastline offering spectacular views across the Solway Firth and towards the Isle of Man, passing historic Whitehaven, pretty Ravenglass and around Morecambe Bay with the background of the Lake District Mountains aglow with the setting sun.


Travelling alongside the stunning Exe Estuary past Powderham Castle there are magnificent views across to the Jurassic coast as our train takes the exciting sea wall line racing through tunnels and cuttings of red rock and along beaches and coves at Dawlish with the sea keeping company all the way to Newton Abbot.

There is a choice of two destinations in which to relax before our return in the late afternoon.

Torquay – One of Britain's top tourist resorts and a jewel in the English Rivera's crown made popular by the Victorians with sparkling white Villas perched on verdant hilltops overlooking pure sandy beaches and an azure sea it matches anything you'll find on the French Riviera. There are beautiful gardens and a palm tree lined promenade leading to a lively harbour and international marina with an abundance of pavement cafes, pubs, shops, and quality restaurants

Paignton – With gorgeous long sandy blue flag beaches, paddler friendly waters, a traditional pier and seafront alive with holiday fun there is no shortage of things to do, alternatively take a steam train ride (payable locally) along one of the most idyllic stretches of coastline in the country and through the woodland estate once owned by Agatha Christie to the riverside station at Kingswear where it's a short ferry crossing to historic Dartmouth.

Step aboard the Midland Pullman for a truly amazing and unusual day tour as we travel over the world-famous West Highland line, featuring some of the most dramatic and spectacular scenery in Scotland with magnificent waterfalls and peaceful lochs to Oban for an afternoon sightseeing break.

Our train takes the route around the north of Glasgow and along the banks of the Clyde to join the West Highland line, thence crossing viaducts as the line twists and turns passing Loch Long and Loch Lomond, we climb into the highlands with stunning views of magnificent mountains and one memorable sight following another as we pass along tranquil Loch Awe and through the Pass of Brander to Oban.

Oban affords magnificent views across the bay to the islands of the Inner Hebrides. It has become a magnet for tourists and is known as the holiday capital of the Highlands and seafood capital of Scotland. There is the Distillery with excellent visitor tours or perhaps wander along the seafront to the ruined Dunollie Castle or climb McCaig's Tower which dominates the skyline.






Saturday: Following departure from your local station our train travels north through the Scottish Lowlands before crossing the legendary and iconic Forth Bridge, then joining the Highland line which takes us toward Perth and Pitlochry – climbing over magnificent mountain scenery and the highest railway summit in Britain at Druimuachdar and passing through the Cairngorm National Park to Inverness with an arrival at approximately 20.00.

Sunday: Departing Inverness around 09.00 we enjoy one of the 'Great Railway Journeys of the World' - the spectacular and scenic coast to coast highland route takes us through Dingwall and over the high plateau at Achnasheen, where great herds of wild deer roam, before descending to sea level and around the shore of beautiful Loch Carron to Kyle of Lochalsh, with stunning views across to the Isle of Skye. Our train returns in the afternoon retracing the scenic journey to Inverness.

Monday: At around 09.00 we depart Inverness for the homeward journey passing Culloden and over Slochd Summit with magnificent views of the Cairngorm Mountains passing the ski centre of Aviemore and onward through the impressive Pass of Killiecrankie, Perth, and Stirling.









This special tour includes a journey over the entire majestic route of the famous Settle to Carlisle railway, with great limestone peaks and deep valleys we travel over viaducts and through tunnels on this masterpiece of Victorian engineering including the famous Ribblehead Viaduct. 


